GPLN member Laninco has moved 2,800 tonnes of cargo for a power plant in Costa Rica

Laninco S.A. from Costa Rica moved several multiple heavy load elements for the Geothermal Binary Power Plant from Port Caldera (Puerto de Caldera) to Las Pailas in Guanacaste Province, in North-Western Costa Rica. The cargo consisted of 17 meters long 75-tonnes condensers, and 12.5 meters long 65-tonnes separators, besides several other units with a weight of up to 60 tonnes. The total charter shipment handled was 1,600 tonnes, and with the addition of regular and other flat rack and open top container cargo, the total weight moved by Laninco for this project came to 2,800 tonnes.

Extended low boy trailers were used for the transportation from Port Caldera to the site in Las Pailas. The cargo was successfully delivered on time, even so some difficulty was caused by weak and low bridges en route.
