GPLN member Global Shipping has handled the shipment of 5 transformers to Nigeria

Global Shipping Services, a GPLN member from Houston in Texas, USA, handled recently a shipment of 5 transformers & 475 cu m of accessories/spares from Houston port to Tin Can Island port and onwards to the final destination at IBESE Cement Plant in Lagos, Nigeria. The shipment consisted of 66 Packages which had a total weight of 312 tons and each of the transformers weighed 49.4 tons and had the dimensions of 4.4 m x 3.2 m x 3.2 m. The transformers were moved to the export terminal in Houston, using heavy duty drop deck trailers and heavy duty oilfield transporters, all moved in bond. The miscellaneous accessories were moved to the terminal using 12 closed box trailers in bond. As the liner vessels were scheduled to depart too late to meet the shippers deadlines, GPLN member Global Shipping Services chartered the vessel MV Muntgracht through Intermarine USA to give them the fastest transit time and to allow them to meet the shippers deadlines for delivery. Mr Brandon Graddy and Mr. Paul McAuley from GPLN member Global Shipping Services in Houston were on site throughout the complete process from shippers yard, for the load out and delivery direct to the vessel and oversaw the vessel loading and stowage.
