GPLN member Maritime Synergy handles heavy equipment from Thailand to Vietnam and Sri Lanka

Maritime Synergy (Thailand) Co., Ltd., a GPLN member based in Chonburi, Thailand, has recently handled various shipments out of Thailand to Vietnam and Sri Lanka.

The first shipment was loaded at Laem Chabang Port and transported to Ho Chi Minh Port in Vietnam. A 12-ton hydraulic umbilical for subsea valves was secured to a 40-foot flat rack and loaded on the 18,595-deadweight-ton container vessel "Kuo Hung". The umbilical measured 3.7 meters long, 4.2 meters wide and 4.5 meters high.

GPLN member Maritime Synergy's second shipment out of Laem Chabang was also transported to Ho Chi Minh Port. Two 40-ton stream drier machines were loaded on the "Leader SW", a 11,968-deadweight-ton general cargo ship. Each machine measured 10.4 meters long, 2.7 meters wide and 3.4 meters high.

The third shipment was delivered from Bangkok Port to Colombo Port in Sri Lanka. Two 52-ton transformers, each measuring 5.6 meters long, 2.4 meters wide and about 4 meters high, were loaded on the 9,994 deadweight-ton general cargo ship "Del Sol", along with 22 packages with a total volume of 208 cubic meters.
