GPLN member World Logistics Consulting delivers a transformer from Texas to Ohio

World Logistics Consulting, Inc., a GPLN member from Chicago, USA, transported a transformer from the Port of Houston in Texas to a First Energy Substation in Niles, Ohio, USA. The 196-ton cargo was unloaded from the Rickmers Singapore vessel onto the rail car earlier last month. The transformer measured about 37 feet long, 12 feet wide and 14.5 feet high. World Logistics Consulting supervised the discharge of the transformer at the port and handled the rail transportation from Houston to Niles. Upon arrival in Ohio, the company coordinated the trans loading, short distance haul, offloading and setting of the transformer onto its pad. In the meantime, GPLN member World Logistics Consulting is working on another railcar movement. A total of 15,000 cubic meters of steel structures manufactured in South Korea will arrive in Canada and be transported to Edmonton, Alberta, for the Walterdale Bridge Replacement Project.
