GPLN member Tuscor Lloyds ships boiler from Spain to Mexico

Tuscor Lloyds, a GPLN member from Barcelona in Spain, has handled the shipment of a 137-ton recovery boiler from Spain to Mexico. The cargo consisted of five breakbulk pieces and two 40-foot open top containers. The pieces were collected in Madrid and Toledo and the cargo transported by road to the Port of Bilbao, a distance of about 414 kilometers. Upon arrival at the Port of Bilbao, the cargo was taken to the quay for loading onto a multipurpose vessel. The heaviest pieces, weighing over 46 tons, were lifted onto the ship using a heavy-lift crane and secured with heavy-duty ratchet straps, steel chains and wooden-steel wedges. The voyage to the Port of Altamira took 30 days. The cargo was unloaded onto low-loader trailers for the final leg of the transport to Monterrey, the largest city of the northeastern state of Nuevo León in Mexico, covering some 1,194 kilometers. After arrival in Monterrey GPLN member Tuscor Lloyds delivered the recovery boiler successfully to the customer.
