GPLN member Green Worldwide Shipping handles transport of large tanks

Green Worldwide Shipping, LLC, a GPLN member located in Atlanta, USA, handled the transport of eight tanks from China via the Port of New Orleans to a small shipyard in South Louisiana. The tanks were late in manufacturing and were urgently needed at destination for completion of a project. While these tanks were relatively light at 22,000 kg each they were quite large. Each one measured 5,20 m in diameter and stood 6m high. Green Worldwide Shipping arranged for the tanks to be the last cargo loaded and the first to be discharged. They were secured to the breakbulk vessel's deck. GPLN member Green Worldwide Shipping considered options for the transport from the Port of New Orleans to the jobsite. They determined barge transport would be both the speediest and least costly way to move the cargo. The tanks were discharged in about eight hours directly from the ship to the barge. The tanks occupied about 135 feet of the 140-foot-long barge - the spacing was very tight. The tanks were moved through 180 miles of waterways in only 36 hours. Upon arrival, the tanks were unloaded in four hours and then placed on another barge that the shipyard was building as a permanent home for the tanks.
